



College Credit Opportunity:

For High School of Business™ Students at Graceland University—C.H. Sandage School of Business.

The Graceland University C.H. Sandage School of Business welcomes High School of Business[™] students to apply for admission. Graceland University's beautiful main campus spans 170 acres in the rolling hills of southern Iowa and is located about one hour south of Des Moines in Lamoni. Sandage business students have the opportunity to study at a business school, while benefiting from the university's strong liberal arts environment. Students can choose from majors in Business Administration, Economics, Accounting, Social Media Marketing, Agricultural Business and Sport Management. Flexibility between majors within the school provides students the option to complete two majors within their four years with no additional charge.

Graceland's values of learning, wholeness and community are evident in the enriching curriculum, the engaging athletic and extra curricular opportunities, and the friendliness of students, faculty and staff. Focusing on the whole person is also the reason why the Sandage School of Business emphasizes experiential learning. Learning by doing is critical to seeing how classroom concepts translate to the real world. Students have the option to participate in Graceland's nationally-recognized Enactus program, part of the Sandage Center for the Study of Free Enterprise and Entrepreneurship. Being a member of this team gives you the chance to put your business skills into action while working on and managing student-generated projects in the community. Some of these projects might involve the campus or local community, while others might focus on the global community. The common element is the application of free market principles in making the world a better place. Other student organizations include Agricultural Business Club, Investment Club, Community Development Club, Omicron Delta Epsilon (International economics honor society), and over 35 more. At the Sandage School, students will also have the opportunity to participate in an internship, interact with business professionals within class or during business-focused campus events, do projects with real world businesses, and even make a professional presentation to executives of a Fortune 500 company!

Earning College Credit

High School of Business[™] students nationwide have the opportunity to earn 12 semester hours of Graceland University credit. Credit can be earned for: BUAD1100 Introduction to Business (3 s.h.) ECON1300 Principles of Macroeconomics (3 s.h.) BUAD0000 Business Elective Credit (6 s.h.)

Procedure:

- Graduate from a high school participating in the High School of Business™ program, completing all six required courses with a grade of C or better.
- Complete the <u>Graceland University application for undergraduate admission</u> and satisfy university admission requirements. Identify in the application that you will be completing the High School of Business™ program.
- Enroll at the Graceland University Lamoni campus as a full-time student. After final official high school transcripts showing satisfactory completion of the High School of Business™ program, as described above, are received, the 12 s.h. of credit will be applied. Grades for the credit will appear on the Graceland University transcript as P for passing and will not factor into your GPA.

Graceland University High School of Business Scholarship:

This scholarship is available to High School of Business students who have successfully completed the HSB program, including all six required courses with a grade of a C or better, and who have been admitted to Graceland University.

The scholarship is a commitment from the University that at least 50% of tuition will be covered by institutional academic scholarships for up to four years of full-time enrollment.

Any changes in tuition will result in a recalculation of the High School of Business Scholarship and adjustments will be made. In cases where a student's other institutional scholarship awards are already at or above 50% of tuition, the HSB Scholarship will be an additional \$1,000 in their financial aid award.
